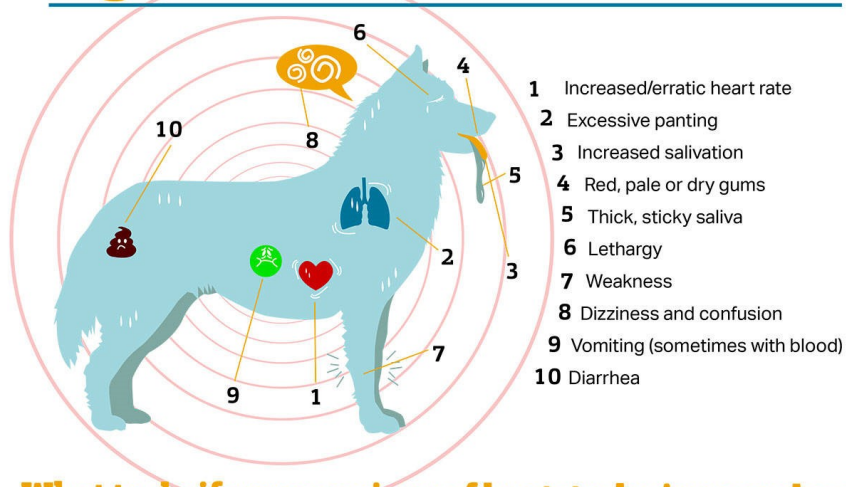


Signs of HEATSTROKE Include:



What to do if you see signs of heatstroke in your dog:



Remove dog from the hot area *immediately.*



Allow free access to cool water if your dog can drink on his own.

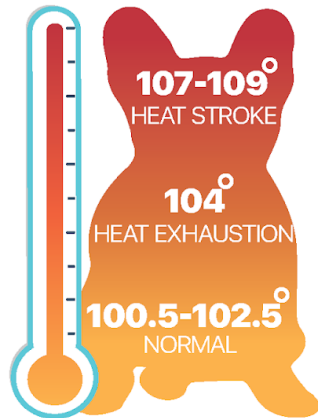


Do not try to force-feed cold water, as your dog may inhale and choke.



Take your dog into a full service veterinary clinic for evaluation and further treatment.

SIGNS OF HEAT STROKE

- Heavy panting, difficulty breathing, excessive thirst
- Bright red tongue and mucus membranes, which turn grey as shock sets in
- Thick saliva, drooling, vomiting, and/or diarrhea
- Unsteadiness and staggering
- Lethargy
- By the time signs of heat stroke are visible, it's often too late.**
