Nevada SPCA Pet Estate Planning Agreement

The following agreement between _____ (Legal name of owner(s) and Nevada Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (known here as Nevada SPCA) is to guarantee that Nevada SPCA will take custody of your pet _____ (name of pet), a _____ (list species here: dog, cat, rabbit, guinea pig, rat), should you become incapacitated and unable to care for your pet and/or if you should predecease your pet.

Nevada SPCA promises the humane treatment of your pet including comfortable housing, food, enrichment activities and medical care until we find a new home for your pet. As Nevada SPCA is a no-kill animal shelter, your pet will remain in our care as long as it is necessary to rehome your pet unless your pet is deemed medically suffering by our veterinary department. Nevada SPCA can arrange transportation as well to pick up and secure your pet from your home with a contact person designated by the executor/trustee of your estate.

There is no required donation for Nevada SPCA to guarantee our care for your pet here.

However, you can designate a bequest in your trust or add Nevada SPCA as a beneficiary on your IRA or life insurance policy to assist with the expenses of the care of your pet at Nevada SPCA.
